### SUGGESTED ITINERARY :

#### Day 01 **Origin/Madeira**

Arrival to Madeira airport. Meet & Greet and departure from airport to the hotel with an introductory tour covering some of the city's highlights.

Dinner at Chalet Vicente restaurant. Providing a unique eno-gastronomic experience, one can find here a rich traditional Portuguese cuisine, regional products, and typical dishes with new influences.

#### Day 02 **Funchal's visit**

Yes, we may guide you along Funchal's streets but, what if we divide you into teams, give you a road book for you to follow, together with a quiz that you must answer as you go along? We invite you to discover the island's capital in a fun, different way: a Pedy Paper, or "walking" rally across Funchal. Meeting point will be the Marina, at the Solar da Santola restaurant, where lunch will take place.

After lunch, we will try two very different means of transportation: the modern cable car will take us to Monte, where, after a short walk, we will experience another mean of transport, not so modern but equally attractive, the famous sledge ride – toboggan. You don't want to miss it!

Dinner at Adega da Quinta Restaurant. Found amongst the vineyards, a few Km west of Funchal, the Adega da Quinta was specially created for a different gastronomic event. You will taste Madeira's typical food, while being entertained by a local folklore group.

#### Day 03 **Boat Safari**

Enjoy the crisp mountain air and the fresh sea breeze by combining a sailing trip along the coast with a half day Jeep Safari! The catamaran will dock in the pier of Câmara de Lobos, where lunch will take place at Vila do Peixe restaurant. It commands a spectacular view of this picturesque fishermen village, reflecting the finest traditions of preparing fresh fish by the sea.

In the afternoon, on board of 4X4 vehicles, we will enjoy great views over the mountains and the valleys and will have the opportunity of preparing Madeira's "National drink", the poncha.

Dinner at The Ritz Café. The Ritz Café Madeira was opened in 1905 by Christian Ritz, a New York businessman whose family was originally from Switzerland, and is nowadays one of the oldest cafes and restaurants in Funchal.
