THE OLYMPIC MUSEUM IN TOTAL METAMORPHOSIS

After 20 years of existence, the institution closed its doors on 29 January 2012 for renovations until the end of 2013.

The renovation of The Olympic Museum reflects the ambition to make this place a veritable "Olympic Campus". The Museum will offer 3,000m2 and three levels of permanent exhibitions, 650m2 of temporary galleries, including an art gallery, with a view over Lake Geneva and the Alps, Two Learning zones for young groups, Hospitality areas, with a 170-seat auditorium, meeting rooms, a restaurant and a 170-seat banquet room.
