

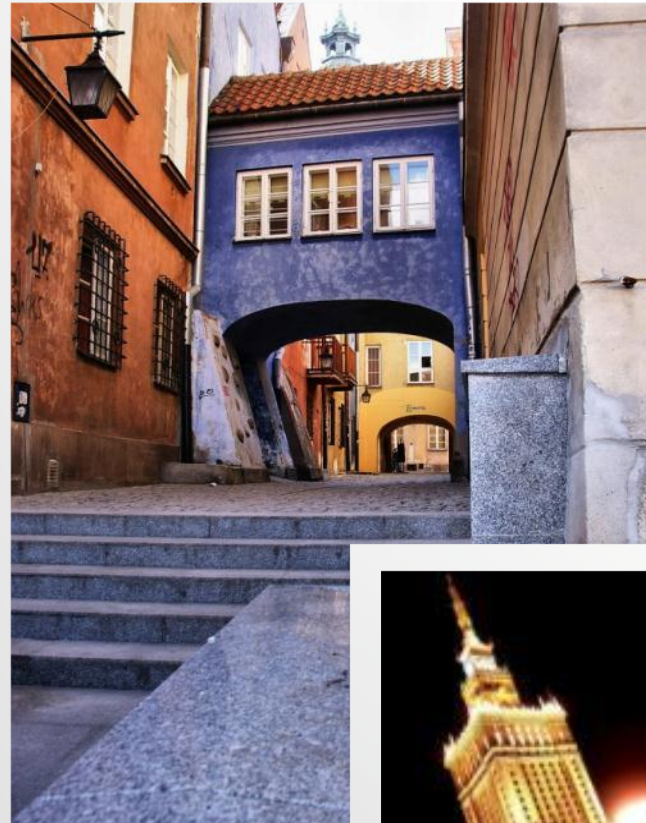

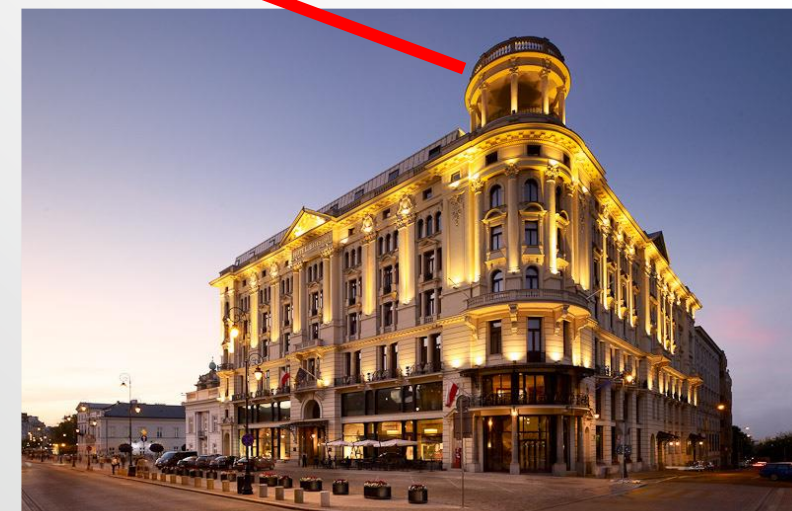
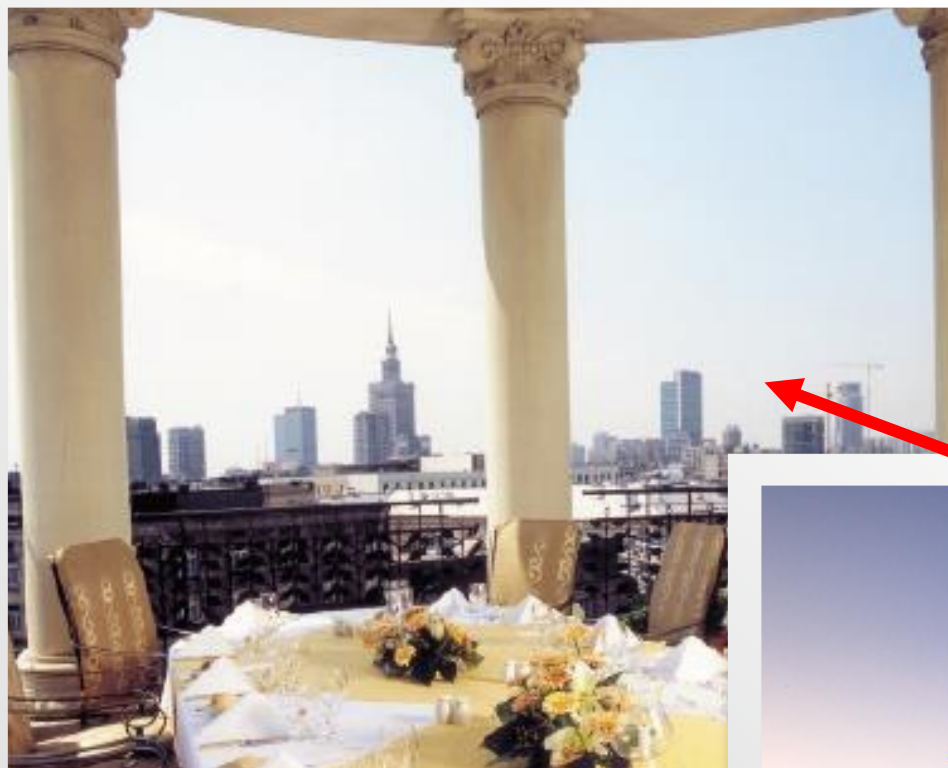

GUIDED CITY TOUR – OLD TOWN

Route: Castle Square, Old Town, New Town, Barbican

Location: city centre

Group size: 15-20 pax / 1 guide

Duration: 2-3 hours



The Warsaw Old Town Route runs through the historic centre and the oldest (12th century) part of the city. It constitutes the cultural centre of the capital city. Two historic squares – the Old Town Market and the New Town Market – are transformed during the summer into a musical stage on which highly appreciated jazz concerts take place, a theatre arena, and an open-air art gallery. The Old Town, completely destroyed during World War II, was faithfully restored and is listed as an UNESCO World Cultural and Natural Heritage Site.

FRIDAY DINNER TRANSFER BY RETRO TRAMS

Route: Castle Square, Bankowy Square, Marszałkowska, Jerusalem Alleys – Ch. de Gaulle's Roundabout

Location: city centre

Group size: 20 pax / 1 carriage

Duration: 25 minutes

Would you like to do something unusual? There is no better way than a transfer in Warsaw style on board of an original 1920s retro tram. We can combine this ride with an aperitif and provide a music player (accordionist). The transfer from the Castle Square to Ch. de Gaulle's Roundabout should take around 25 minutes.

For 34 pax we suggest 2 trams so that everyone can have a seat and enjoy a ride through the very centre of city!

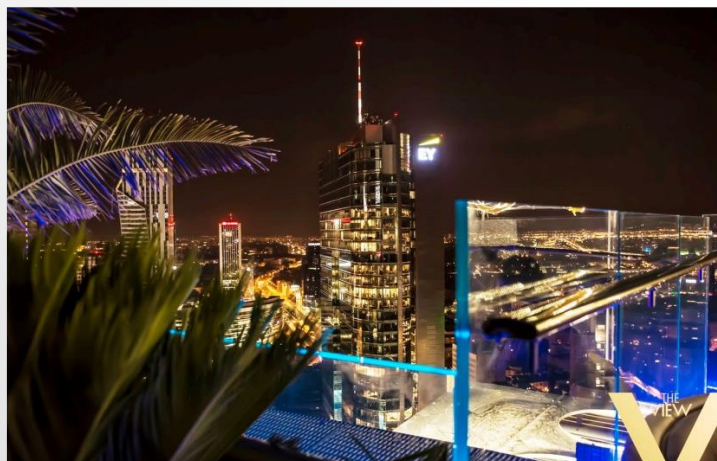
SKYBAR NIGHT ENTERTAINMENT

POLIN - The Museum of the History of Polish Jews functions as an important cultural and educational center with a rich cultural program and exhibitions. LUNCH IN THE SKY!

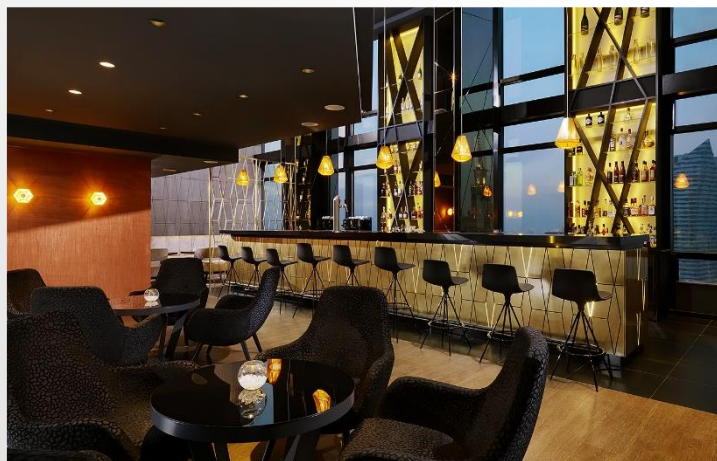
Venue: Panorama Sky Bar at the Marriott Hotel

Duration: 3-4 hours



The park-and-palace complex, Łazienki Park (literally Baths Park), is the largest park in Warsaw and a former summer retreat of Polish kings.

The Old Łazienki Orangery with its Sculpture Gallery is a perfect venue for an exclusive dinner set up in historical interiors which are bright and spacious. Unforgettable atmosphere of the evening is created by the collection of copies of ancient Greek and Roman sculptures arranged similarly to sculpture alleys in ancient gardens. The venue usually opened for tourist will be at your private disposal.

The dinner will be preceded by a short guided walk around the Park to show the guests its highlights such as Palace on the Isle.

To accompany the dinner at the Old Łazienki Orangery we suggest a private concert of mellow tunes of the most celebrated Polish composer Frederic Chopin.

Type of cuisine: Polish, French

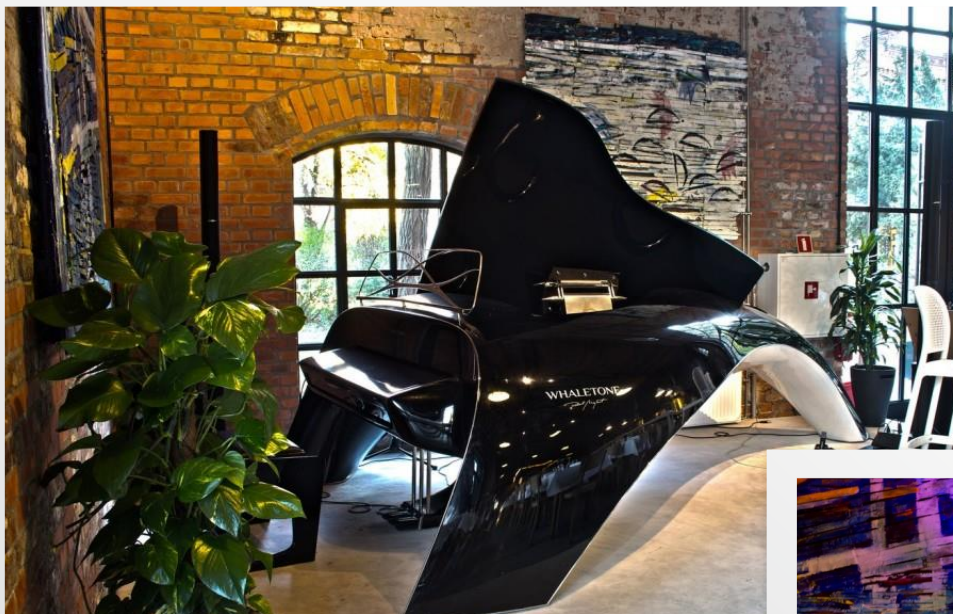

Route: Pick up at the hotel/ venue – Constitution Square – Palace of Culture and Science – Ministry of Agriculture - the Party's House - Praga district - Communism Museum - drop off at the hotel/ venue

Location: city centre

Duration: 3 hours

We will pick the group from the conference venue in the original socialist-style vans of historical value, i.e. Nysa 522. The group will be taken for a unique trip through the legacy of the Polish socialism. Not only will they see the places connected with it, but they will experience them as well. At the end they will visit the Museum of Life under Communism where they will experience a small apartment furnished in socialist style, a communist party member's office, a shop, a bar and a street from the era. The museum shows how people used to live and watch propaganda movies of the 1950s.

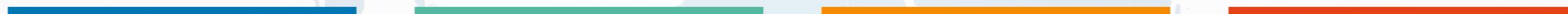
